



CANADIAN PRIMARY ALUMINIUM PRODUCTION MONTHLY REPORT

February 5, 2021 — The Aluminium Association of Canada reports that primary aluminium production in Canada in January 2021 totalled 275,199 metric tons. The monthly production was up 0,53% in comparison with the month of December 2020. The year-to-date average daily production is 8,877 tons. Compared to last year, the annual projection of production would be up by 3,90%.
